Judging: For all classes not judged by weight or measurement, the judging will be by public vote for favourite exhibits. The public vote will close at 11.15 so that votes can be counted and results announced.

CLASSES OF ENTRY

FLOWERS

- 1. Garden Flowers annuals/biennials/perennials one vase of one kind
- 2. **Garden Flowers** annuals/biennials/perennials one vase of mixed kinds
- 3. Chrysanthemums 3 blooms, any variety can be mixed varieties
- 4. Dahlias 3 blooms, any variety can be mixed varieties

FLORAL ART

- 5. 'Fascinating Foliage' a vase of Autumnal Foliage & Berries any tree or shrub
- 6. 'Autumn Glory' space for each exhibit 60cm square, open staging
- 7. 'Harvest Supper' a table decoration to include or be based on a potato and to include fruit, nuts, veg etc

Classes 6 & 7 may contain fresh and/or dried leaves, flowers, stems, seed heads, fruits, vegetables etc. together with any item appropriate to the theme!

FRUIT

- 8. **Apples**, dessert or cooking 3 named variety if possible
- 9. **Pears**, dessert 3 named variety if possible
- 10. A basket of Home-grown Fruit to be judged on presentation, quality and variety

VEGETABLES

- 11. **Culinary Herbs** mixed, not flowering, in water
- 12. 'October Harvest' a collection of mixed vegetables displayed in a container, to be judged on presentation, quality and variety
- 13. **Chillies** 3 named variety if possible
- 14. Pumpkin or Winter Squash any variety
- 15. Longest Carrot to be judged on measurement only

COOKERY

- 16 **Cupcakes** a plate of 3 decorated cupcakes. To be judged on presentation only
- 17. **Decorated Biscuits** a plate of 3 decorated biscuits. To be judged on presentation only

FUN

- 18. Photograph 'A Walk in the Woods'
- 19. **A Pumpkin** made from any material can be made of wood, wool, fabric etc





Show Rules

- 1. Classes 1-4 and 8-15 must be home-grown.
- 2. Entries to be brought to Uplyme Village Hall at 9.30am on the day of the show.
- 3. Class cards will be issued for each entry at the registration desk upon arrival.
- 4. Exhibitors to provide their own receptacles.
- 5. No exhibitor may enter more than one exhibit in any one class.
- This is a "fun" competition designed for the enjoyment of members and supporters of the Society, and to encourage everyone to have a go at entering. Judging in all classes will be by popular vote or by weight and measurement and not to RHS Rules.
- 7. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be held responsible for any loss of, or damage to, exhibits.
- 8. In the event of any question or dispute, the decision of the Committee will be final.
- 9. All Entries must be removed at 12 noon on the day of the show.
